Introduction & background:

With the new Sustainable Development Goals agreed many policy makers, civil servants, educational providers and civil society organisations are seeing how to make this Agenda a reality on national level. This is a serious challenge and many of us have been struggling to get clear information, useful good practices or other partners to work on common advocacy with. Or to how to link the national level to the policy processes or resources available at global level, at the UN or UNESCO.

As organisations that have been working on advocacy on target 4.7 for the last three years, we have seen this need appear and are joining up to help address it. We therefore are setting up the Bridge 47 Network for all who are interested in working together on reaching the target 4.7

It aims to

- use Target 4.7 of the sustainable Development Goals as the political basis for this work,
- to facilitate cooperation around its implementation and
- to achieve successful educational policies and other relevant policies around the world.
- to connect all lifelong learning actors working on this and to consciously embed its work in a lifelong learning understanding of education.

It is a Bridge to connect educational actors and policy makers that are too often disconnected and working in their own policy silos. Both the different 'value-educations' such as ESD, HRE, Peace, gender, Culture,.. as well as the different actors: students, teachers, adult educators, music teachers, researchers,... We believe that none of us can achieve this alone and that a real deep understanding of how our educations support each other is the basis for success.

Objective:

This webinar will inform on the general process of implementation of SDG's and Target 4.7.

The webinar will inform on the policy process of UNESCO and give feedback on how civil/education society would like to see this process set up so they can engage.

The webinar will present the Bridge 47 Network and how people can engage/contribute and learn in the Network.

And the webinar will discuss different options on how to start implementing on national level: How to connect to overall SDG process? How to find national partners? How to used UNESCO/UN resources?
